The Challenge Facing Educational Institutions

Educational institutions are adopting AI, cloud platforms, digital learning systems and data-driven services faster than governance, capability and cybersecurity controls are maturing.

01 Unstructured AI adoption Staff and learners may already use generative AI without an institutional policy, clear boundaries or agreed quality standards.	02 Cyber risk is increasing Education holds sensitive personal, academic and financial data while users, devices and third-party platforms create a broad attack surface.
03 Technology remains fragmented Systems are often introduced independently, creating duplication, weak integration and limited visibility across the learner journey.	04 Skills vary widely Leadership, faculty, instructors, administrative staff and learners require different levels of digital, AI and cyber capability.
05 Leaders lack a common baseline Without a structured assessment, investment priorities are driven by urgency, vendor claims or isolated initiatives rather than evidence.	06 Compliance and trust are at stake Weak data handling, unclear accountability and inconsistent digital practice can undermine quality, reputation and stakeholder confidence.

How the Assessment Works

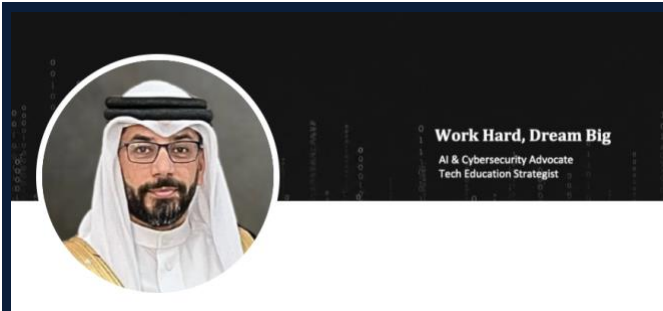
1	Discover	Confirm objectives, scope, stakeholders, institutional context and priority concerns.
2	Collect Evidence	Use leadership interviews, staff surveys, learner input, document review and selected system/process checks.
3	Score & Validate	Assess each dimension against the five-level maturity model and validate findings through evidence triangulation.
4	Prioritise	Identify critical risks, capability gaps, quick wins and improvement actions based on impact and feasibility.
5	Roadmap & Brief	Present the executive findings, detailed report, training priorities and phased implementation roadmap.
